

From the Warring States period to the Edo Period, politics and culture developed in the castle town of Matsushiro Castle. Visitors can explore historical sites associated with the samurai Sanada family and Zozan Sakuma, a politician who advocated the opening of Japanese ports to foreign traders.

ere the Sanada family?

The long-established Sanada family from East Shinshu expanded their influence as a local ruling family and survived turbulent times from the Warring States period, the age of rival warlords, to the 400 year-long Edo Period. Matsushiro retains the stateliness of the simple samural spirit of the Sanada family.



What's Rokumonsen?



Rokumonsen is the Sanada fam emblem. Tradition has it that the emble came into use after Yukitaka Sanada used it on his banner.

he achievements of Zozan

Zozan Shrine / Kogi-tei / Zozan Museum Kogi-tei is a building steeped in history and the place where Zozan Sakuma debated about the condition of the government with various guests. The museum exhibits electrical medical equipment made by Zozan and teaches us about his talents.

Who was Zozan Sakuma?

In 1868, Japan ended its isolationist foreign policy and began negotiations with other countries. Zozan Sakuma (1811-1864) of the Matsushiro Clan, an advocate for the opening up of Japan. laid the foundations for this to come about. He was a skilled linguist and scientist, and his writings, drawings and sites of experiments, which show his regard for the technology of Western culture, industry and telegraphic communication, can be found at the Zozan Museum and in the town.



Matsushiro-yaki

Beautiful pottery Matsushiro-yaki is the name of the pottery which was created in the early part of the 18th century in the castle town of the Sanada family, Matsushiro. It is unique for its simple form and weight and its distinctive blue-green glaze. Although the pottery can be purchased, visitors who wish to make one should go to the workshop.




Matsushiro-so-Local Government **Operated Inn (Matsushiro Onsen)**

Matsushiro-so is famous for its peculiar reddish-brown hot spring and as being the secret hot spring reputed to have healed Shingen Takeda's soldiers. The 100% natural hot spring never stops flowing. As the water contains a large amount of sodium, it warms the body right through.
